



2024 Annual Report

Introduction:

Literacy Ministry Ukraine (LMU) became an LEI Member Nation partner in 2021. It provides local literacy teacher training workshops, Bible-based reading primers and coaching of new literacy teachers. In addition, LMU also provides teaching English as a foreign language (EFL). LMU's board consists of 7 board members.

Viktoriia Rohozhnikova graduated from the International Literacy Training Institute in Tulsa, Oklahoma, in August 2018 and has served as a missionary in Ukraine since 2019.

Support during the time of war

In February 2022 Russia attacked Ukraine and occupied some of its territories. Many people moved to other locations and besides Literacy Ministry and EFL Ministry, LMU also have supported many individuals and families providing food packages, medicine and reading glasses, hygiene items, clothes and shoes to support people in need as well, sharing the Good News with them.











EFL Ministry

English as a Foreign Language continued both online and as in-person classes. Some new students joined the classes while others had to move out of Kherson because of danger of staying here.



23 teenagers have been reached through EFL classes from the Youth Ministry in the Living Well Church.

Another smaller group joined EFL classes online.

These are four girls from 2 related families. Because of the war they had to leave Ukraine, so one family is in Latvia now and the other in Germany.



Literacy Ministry



There was one Tutor Training Workshop held at Berezivka, Odesa region, — a settlement of Roma people. The local pastor moved to the place several years ago from Kharkiv, Eastern Ukraine, to work with the Roma people as he is a Roma person himself and wants his people to be saved. Vladimir and his youngest son went through the TTW as well as a missionary couple who came from the same location as Vladimir to serve Roma people. Another tutor, Marina, had a double role: she got her training for the Russian primer (last year she was trained how to teach with Ukrainian primer) and at the same time she was an assistant and helped even introducing some material.

Marina and our previously trained tutor, Oksana, are both from Odesa and serve to the Roma groups, visiting a village with many Roma people who need literacy. They already had some literacy classes there with a group of seven children. At the moment that Roma center does some renovations, but by Spring, 2025 they welcome the tutors to visit them again.




FINANCIAL REPORT 2024

Planned

- 1. We had to postpone printing the rest of the primers because of safety reasons: the place that we were going to use for the storage place was hit by a missile. Fortunately, the primers were not placed there yet. At the same time the place where other printed materials are kept is not big enough to fit more printed materials.

 As soon as the situation stabilizes we need to print about 100 sets each of A4 and A5 size primers in Russian.
- 2. Currently we are planning a TTW in Western part of Ukraine sometime in Spring, 2025.
- 3. Viktoriia Rohozhnikova is invited to be a part of Primer Construction team in Serbia this Spring.
